### PROMISE AUCTION, SATURDAY 17 JULY IN THE PAVILION AT 8.00 PM

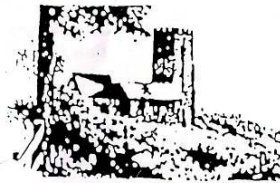
