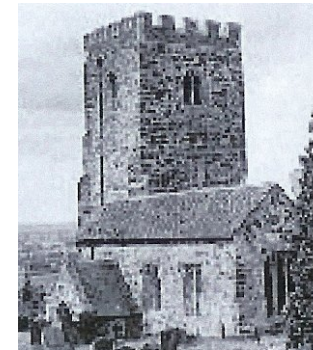

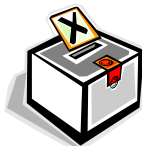

We look forward to seeing all our old friends, together with any new ones who may be interested in joining us.

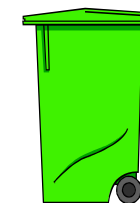

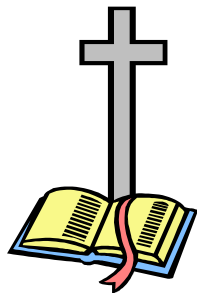

This phrase was included in a leaflet I have recently received about Christian Aid Week, which takes place from May 13th to 19th. It is the biggest house-to-house collection in the UK, involving up to 300,000 people in door-to-door collections and other activities. Many people will be challenged to think about those in need in our world, and 6 million households in this country will respond to the collection.

Christian Aid is only one amongst many charities working to give the world’s poorest communities an opportunity to improve their lives.
